ISSUE: H1N1 / Swine Flu

H1N1 / Swine Flu is a new type of influenza which has recently been discovered in humans. Outbreak of this new influenza continues to slowly expand in the United States. According to recent reports from World Health Organization (WHO), there are approximately 9,000 cases in the United States, which has resulted in 15 deaths.

The virus spreads from human to human and can cause illness. It can spread through coughing, sneezing, or contact by an infected person. To prevent spreading this infection, people should cover their mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing, and wash their hands regularly.

Currently, there are no vaccines available for the H1N1 virus, so proper preventive measures are very important.
