Glenn M. Landers is a Senior Research Associate at the Georgia Health Policy Center. Mr. Landers' primary areas of expertise are in long-term care and access for the uninsured. Since joining the center in 1999, Mr. Landers has led a variety of projects informing long-term care and end-of-life care policies and programs.

Mr. Landers' current projects include evaluating the expansion of Georgia's Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC) for the Georgia Department of Human Resources Division of Aging Services and evaluating a state disease management program for approximately 100,000 aged, blind, and disabled Medicaid consumers for APS Healthcare and United Healthcare.

Mr. Landers completed his undergraduate work at Syracuse University and received both an MBA and an MHA from Georgia State University. He is currently working on a doctoral degree at Tulane University.
